



CRABAPPLE

Flowering crabapples (*Malus*) are wonderful additions to the landscape. In May, these distinguished specimens burst with showy buds and vibrant flowers in rich hues of pink, red and white. In September, small red, maroon or gold fruit adorn the trees. The fruit may persist through the winter if the birds don't devour it first. They prefer well-drained soil and require at least 6 hours of direct sun for best flower and fruit development. Little pruning is required. If needed, prune immediately after bloom since most crabapples set buds for the next season in mid-June to early July.

Name	Form	HxW	Description
Adirondack	Upright	18'x10'	Green foliage. White flowers. ½" bright red fruit. Densely branched tree is shaped like an inverted cone. Excellent disease resistance.
April Showers	Weeping	8'x4'	Green foliage. Light pinkish white flowers are followed by bright red fruit. Tight weeping habit makes this form ideal for smaller gardens.
Coralburst	Rounded	15'x15'	Small dark green foliage. Compact form. Coral pink buds open into double rose-colored flowers. ½" bronze fruit. Fair disease resistance.
Donald Wyman	Rounded	20'x24'	Glossy, medium green foliage. Single white flowers. Persistent, ⅜" bright red fruit is abundant. Good disease resistance.
Firebird	Spreading	8'x10'	Dark green foliage. Red buds open to profuse white flowers. ⅜" dark red fruit persists well into winter. Very heavy bloomer and a gorgeous, abundant display of fruit. Perfect for size-restricted spaces. Excellent disease resistance.
Golden Raindrops	Upright vase	18'x12'	Deeply cut green foliage. Delicate, star-like, white flowers are profuse. ¼" fruit is golden yellow. Excellent disease resistance.
Lollipop	Rounded	10'x10'	Green foliage. Fragrant, single white flowers are followed by persistent, ⅜" golden yellow fruit. Good dwarf form for small areas. Good disease resistance.
Louisa	Weeping	12'x15'	Graceful weeping branches are upswept at the tips. Rose-colored buds open to gorgeous, true pink flowers. Scattered lemon yellow fruits from late July to mid-November. Excellent disease resistance.
Pink Princess	Spreading	8'x12'	Purple spring foliage becoming bronze green. Rose magenta buds open to rosy pink flowers. ¼" deep red fruit is sparsely produced. Great small specimen tree. Excellent scab resistance.
Pink Sparkles	Pyramidal	15'x12'	Glossy green foliage with crimson buds opening to warm blush pink flowers. Cherry red fruit is persistent. Excellent disease resistance.

Name	Form	HxW	Description
Prairiefire	Rounded	20'x20'	Red-maroon foliage, aging to reddish green. Crimson buds develop into single pinkish red single flowers. Persistent $\frac{3}{8}$ " dark red fruit. Good disease resistance.
Purple Prince	Rounded	18'x18'	Purple leaves becoming bronze-green. Rose-red flowers and persistent $\frac{3}{8}$ " maroon to dark purple fruit. Interesting purplish bark. Excellent disease resistance.
Red Jewel	Upright pyramidal	18'x12'	Green foliage. Pure white, single flowers. $\frac{1}{2}$ ", brilliant red fruit is persistent until March. Narrower than many standard crabapples and the most disease resistant variety that we carry.
Royal Gem	Rounded	8'x8'	New leaves are crimson red becoming dark green with a red hue underneath. White-eyed, rose-red flowers in spring and $\frac{1}{4}$ " dark red fruit in fall. Compact, upright form. Excellent disease resistance.
Royal Raindrops	Upright vase	18'x12'	Deeply cut purple foliage, aging to reddish green. Bright pinkish red flowers. $\frac{1}{2}$ " red fruit is persistent. Orange-red fall foliage. Excellent disease resistance.
Ruby Tears	Weeping	8'x12'	Burgundy-green foliage. Dark pink flowers followed by $\frac{3}{8}$ " red fruit. Graceful weeping form.
Sargent	Spreading	8'x10'	Dark green foliage. Dwarf, dense form. Profuse, fragrant, white, single, $\frac{1}{2}$ " flowers. Abundant, $\frac{1}{4}$ " dark red fruit are persistent. Excellent disease resistance.
Show Time	Oval	20'x15'	Dark green foliage with a reddish cast. Fuchsia red flowers. $\frac{5}{8}$ " cherry red fruit. Excellent disease resistance.
Spring Sensation	Spreading	10'x10'	Chicagoland Grows selection. Dark rose to rose-magenta flower buds open to abundant pink-tinted flowers. Fruit production minimal to none. Dense, red-tinged foliage. Excellent disease resistance.
Snow Drift	Rounded	20'x20'	Green foliage. Pink buds open to pure white flowers. $\frac{3}{8}$ " orange berries remain on tree into winter. Good disease resistance.
Sugar Tyme	Spreading	15'x12'	Green foliage. Pink buds open to sugary white flowers. Persistent $\frac{1}{2}$ " red fruit in fall. Good disease resistance.
Tina	Spreading	5'x6'	Medium green foliage. Dwarf form. Bright red buds open to single white flowers. $\frac{1}{4}$ " bright red fruit. Excellent disease resistance. Tree or shrub form.
Zumi	Rounded	20'x20'	Green foliage. Red buds open to pinkish white flowers. $\frac{3}{8}$ " glossy red fruit persists into winter. Branches are gracefully spreading. Excellent disease resistance.
